



PATRICK CORSO
RESORT PRESIDENT & CEO

Having joined Mount Washington Resort as Resort President and CEO in 2006, Patrick Corso brought to this new position more than 30 years of esteemed resort and hospitality experience. In this current role, Corso is responsible for positioning Mount Washington Resort as the preeminent historic and year-round resort destination in New England.

When the resort was acquired in June of 2006 by Celebration Associates and Crosland, Inc., the new owners appointed National Resort Management Group, LLC, of which Corso is a founder and managing partner, to market and operate the property. Corso and his team oversee more than 900 acres of land and other assets including the 18-hole Mount Washington golf course designed by Donald Ross, an adjacent nine-hole course, an equestrian center, Nordic ski center, and more. A full-scale renovation project totaling \$50 million is currently in progress. Mount Washington Resort includes The Mount Washington Hotel, Bretton Arms Inn, The Lodge, and The Townhomes.

Corso was president of Pinehurst, Inc., from 1987-2004. During his tenure, he oversaw the restoration of Pinehurst and its return to prominence as one of the premier golf resort destinations in the world. In the last 10 years of his tenure with ClubCorp (the owner of Pinehurst), Corso served as executive vice president of Resort Operations and later president of The Pinehurst Company. The collection of resorts in addition to Pinehurst included The Homestead in Hot Springs, VA; Barton Creek Resort in Austin, TX; Firestone Country Club in Akron, OH; Daufuskie Island Resort and Club on Hilton Head, SC; and the Palmilla Resort and Golf Club in Los Cabos, Mexico.

Corso is the Chairman of the Resort Committee for the American Hotel and Lodging Association and also served as a past member of the North Carolina Economic Development Board and as General Chairman of the 1999 US Open Championship won by Payne Stewart. He was also named one of North Carolina's Top 100 Tourism Leaders of the 20th Century by Appalachian State University. He currently serves on the Board of Governors of New Hampshire Public Television, the Board of Trustees for the Mount Washington Observatory, the

Board of Directors for the Business and Industry Association of New Hampshire and is a member of The Royal and Ancient Golf Club of St. Andrews, Scotland.

Corso is a graduate of Ball State University with a BS Degree in Communications. He and his wife Judy have three grown children and reside in Bretton Woods, NH.

About Mount Washington Resort

Set at the base of the stunning 6,288-foot Mount Washington and surrounded by nearly 800,000 acres of the White Mountain National Forest, the Mount Washington Resort is a four-season vacation destination for guests of all ages. Founded in 1876, the Resort offers splendid seasonal activities such as golf, tennis, horseback riding and fly fishing during the summer; and alpine and Nordic skiing, snowboarding, ice climbing, snow tubing, sleigh rides and winter hiking trails during the winter.
