Carroll to Lead Daily Operation of Resort's Championship Golf Courses, Currently Undergoing \$7 Million Restoration and Expansion

BRETTON WOODS, NH, February 22, 2008 – Mount Washington Resort, nestled among nearly 800,000 acres of White Mountain National Forest, is pleased to announce the appointment of Michael Carroll as the new Head Golf Professional for the Resort. Carroll's appointment precedes the debut of a \$7 million golf restoration and expansion project returning the Resort's two courses to championship standards.

In his new role, Carroll will be responsible for the daily management of the Resort's Golf Operations including Member services, on-course management, tournament operations, and the Golf Pro Shop. He will work closely with the Resort's Retail Department to ensure the highest standards are maintained throughout the Mount Washington Resort Golf Club.

Mount Washington Resort currently has 27 holes of golf, including the signature 18-hole Mount Washington Course and the nine-hole Mount Pleasant Course, designed by Brian Silva in 1989. The Mount Washington Golf Course, designed by legendary golf course designer, Donald Ross, originally opened in 1915. Nearly an entire century later, golf architect Brian Silva is using Ross' plans to execute a thorough restoration, which will bring the course back to the brilliance of Ross' original vision. The Mount Washington Golf Course is slated to re-open for play in August 2008. Silva will also be adding nine holes to the Mount Pleasant Course, bringing Mount Washington Resort's golf offerings to a total of 36 holes. The Mount Pleasant Course's 18 holes will debut in 2011.

Set at the base of the stunning 6,288-foot Mount Washington and surrounded by nearly 800,000 acres of the White Mountain National Forest, the Mount Washington Resort is a four-season vacation destination for guests of all ages.
